## THE CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT ACT, 1961

[Act No. III of 1961.] (The 24th March 1961)

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

- 1. This Act may be called the Constitution Amendment Act, 1961.
- For section 2 of the Constitution, the following shall be substituted as section 2, namely: -
  - "2. The Union of Myanmar shall comprise the whole of Myanmar, including-
  - (i) subject to the provisions of Article IX and X of the Boundary Treaty concluded between the Union of Myanmar and the People's Republic of China on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1960 and duly ratified by the respective Governments of the two Parties to the Treaty on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 1961, all the territories administered by the Governor of Myanmar on behalf of His Britannic Majesty;
  - (ii) the Kayah State; and
  - (iii) such other territories as may be acquired."
- 3. For section 5 of the Constitution, the following shall be substituted as section 5, namely:-
  - "5. Subject to the provisions of clause (i) of section 2 the territories that were heretofore known as the Federated Shan States and the Wa States shall form a constituent unit of the Union of Myanmar and be hereafter known as "the Shan State'."
- 4. For section 6 of the Constitution, the following shall be substituted as section 6, namely:-
  - "6. Subject to the provisions of clause (i) of section 2 the territories that were heretofore known as the Myikyina and Bhamo Districts shall form a constituent unit of the Union of Myanmar and be hereafter known as "the Kachin State'."
